After a hard days slog in the mud and grime your lights will be ready for a good scrub. AY UP Lights are fully sealed and can withstand 1 metre water depth so no worries washing under the tap, hose pipe or even pressure hose providing you are at least a metre away.

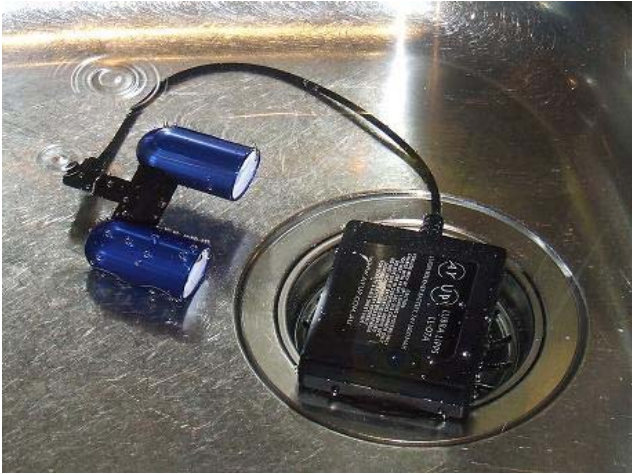


Remove your lights, fill the sink with luke warm soapy water and attack with a sponge or soft bristled brush. Ordinary household washing up liquid is fine.

NOTE: Avoid using bleach or other strong cleaning agents



After you've cleaned the lights rinse under the tap with cold water and wipe clean with a towel or tissue. Blow or shake any water out of the power connector after cleaning.



AY UP batteries are also waterproof to 1 metre and providing they do not enter salt water they can be dropped in with the lights when cleaning. Unplugging and plugging in the lights under water will not cause any problems. Fresh water will not worry the battery circuit. All AY UP batteries have internal circuit protection. Short circuit, over current, under voltage and other smarts are built into the battery packs and are all auto reset components. If the light suddenly goes off under water remove from the water, unplug the light, wait for a second or two until the internal circuits reset themselves and plug back in. If the problem still persists, check the battery and lead for damage and if damaged dispose of properly.

With any battery device it's the connectors that cop the most hammering. To keep your connector in tip top condition smear a small amount of Vaseline or Silicone Grease from time to time.

Pouches and other hardware can also be cleaned this way if desired and it's always best to dry your gear before packing away.
